

Detailed occupational safety and health rules applicable during the TSSP internship taught at Nicolaus Copernicus University

1. During internships students are required to comply absolutely with the sanitary regime, including compliance with the principles of social distancing and the use of personal protective equipment.
2. Before internships, students are informed about the rules of the sanitary regime in which internships will be conducted, and they are required to confirm in writing that they have read their content.
3. Students come to internships without symptoms of respiratory tract infections (fever, cough, breathing difficulties).
4. When entering the university building, students must cover mouth and nose with a protective mask. Hand disinfection is mandatory before entering the class.
5. Students leave the university building no later than 10 minutes after the end of internships.
6. Students must leave any items that are not necessary during internships in the cloakroom.
7. The information about the maximum number of people staying in the room at the same time should be placed on the entrance door.
8. Workstations should be arranged in such a way as to ensure a 1.5-metre distance between students or, if possible, to separate individual workstations with partitions, e.g. made of plexiglass.
9. The rooms should be aired during internships. Breaks cannot be shorter than 30 minutes.
10. Each time the internship starts, the student is required to certify with his/her own signature that during the last 14 days he/she:
 - Has not been in touch with any person diagnosed with COVID-19.
 - Has not had an infection with cough, shortness of breath or fever.
 - Has not been in the quarantine imposed by the Sanitary Inspection.
11. Students who give a negative answer to all the above questions can attend internships. If the answer is positive, the student cannot attend internships personally. The student is placed in solitary confinement and, if his/her health condition is sufficient, should go home by individual transport, stay there and use medical telecounselling.
12. In the event of the appearance of symptoms of infection when staying at home, the student is obliged to immediately notify the coordinator of this fact by e-mail. The student will be informed about further stages of the procedure by e-mail.
